DISPOSITION: Information

BACKGROUND: Welcome to the second meeting of the National Digital Newspaper Program in Ohio Advisory Board. During this meeting, board members will discuss their recommendations for newspapers to be digitized during the 2016-2018 grant cycle and work with project staff to create a preliminary selection list. They will also discuss upcoming outreach projects.

a. Project updates

- We have a new project website available at: <http://ndnpohio.ohiohistory.org/>. This replaces the project wiki that was used throughout the first three grant cycles.
- In January, we selected Northern Micrographics (based in La Crosse, WI) as our vendor for digitization and metadata creation services for this grant project. They have proven experience with NDNP and digitizing foreign-language papers, and their sample reel data and proposal met our requirements for this project.
- The sample reel (Pomeroy/Columbus *Ohio Waisenfreund* series, 1873-1875) was digitized as part of the vendor selection process. It is undergoing some final processing with our vendor and will be submitted to Library of Congress for review and approval in March.

TOPIC: Selection Ground Rules

DISPOSITION: Information

BACKGROUND: Our goal is to select newspapers that are historically significant and represent Ohio's ethnic diversity. The preliminary selection list will include:

- 10-15 titles/title families (6,000-10,000 pages for each title)
- 5-10 year target time period for digital edition of each title
- At most 50% will be German or Hungarian German titles
- At least 50% will be Czech, Hungarian, Lithuanian, Polish, Romanian, Serbo-Croatian, Slovak and Slovenian titles
- At least one title each from Czech, German, Hungarian German, Polish, Romanian and Slovak papers
- Backups for each post-1922 title
- Communities not already represented on *Chronicling America* (if possible)

BACKGROUND: The first set of outreach projects will be completed by the end of September 2017. These will focus on German-language content. Project staff would like input from the advisory board on developing these items.

- a. Educator/student resources (June 2017) will allow users to:
 - Learn more about American history through the eyes of the press and people it serves
 - Delve into deeper multicultural narratives
 - Learn about different perspectives
 - Develop their own resources and projects
- b. Video tutorials (July 2017) may cover:
 - Working with Fraktur font
 - Using online translation services
 - Searching with/without special characters
 - Content and arrangement of foreign language newspapers
- c. Public presentations & programming (September 2017) will:
 - Highlight Ohio's foreign-language content on *Chronicling America*
 - Provide strategies for browsing, searching, translating, etc.
 - Be provided in partnership with local organizations, like:
 - Columbus Maennerchor
 - Germania Society of Cincinnati
 - Ohio Chapter of Palatines to America
