0:01	Once you find an image you would like to print, there are several ways you can do that.
0:05	You can open up an alternate view, either the Text view or the PDF view, to print that version by clicking on those links in the gray navigation bar above the image, or you can click on Clip Image next to the Scissors link at the end of the gray bar above the image.
0:23	A new screen or a new tab will open if you choose to clip the image and it will have citation information such as:
0:31	the Title of the paper, location of publication and years of publication , the date of the issue and the image number of the page and a persistent link to that image.
0:42	If you have zoomed in to a certain section of that page in the Image Viewing Screen and used the Clip Image button to print, only the zoomed in portion of the image will be printed.
0:51	Keep in mind that your search terms will not be highlighted even if they are on the Image Viewing Screen if you are using the clip image button to print.
1:00	And that's the basics of how to print an image on Chronicling America.
