 - Three batches have been submitted to the Library of Congress and are undergoing review. Once accepted, they will be added to Chronicling America.
 - Four other batches are in various stages of processing.

- c. Updates from Annual Awardee Meeting
 - In 2020, Chronicling America records will be integrated with the rest of Library of Congress collections.
 - Library of Congress is increasing their use of LibGuides.
